


Приложение МЭШ (IBClient) можно установить на ПК, планшет или смартфон.

Для скачивания приложения в Библиотеке МЭШ выполните следующие действия:


- 1. Предварительно авторизуйтесь в Библиотеке МЭШ, введя свой логин и пароль в соответствующие поля.





<u>Literary genres</u> are often defined by the cultural expectations and needs of a particular historical and, cultural moment or place.

#### The major literary genres defined by a topic are:

<u>Classic</u> - fiction that has become part of an accepted literary canon, widely taught in schools

<u>Detective</u> - fiction about a crime, how the criminal gets caught and serve time, and the repercussions of the crime

<u>Fantasy</u> - fiction in an unreal setting that often includes magic, magical creatures, or the supernatural

Memoir - factual story that focuses on a significant relationship between the writer and a person, place, or object; reads like a short novel

Mystery - fiction dealing with the solution of a crime or the revealing of secrets

Romance - genre which focuses on the relationship and romantic love between two people, and must have an "emotionally satisfying and optimistic ending"

<u>Science fiction</u> - story based on the impact of actual, imagined, or potential science, often set in the future or on other planets

Western - fiction set in the American Old West frontier and typically in the late nineteenth to early twentieth century


